- 2. There is no budget for the recruitment of the Village Administrators in the 2020/21 financial year of the County Government of Bungoma.
- 3. The wage bill for the County Government of Bungoma is already above the 35% limit as per the Regulation 25 (b) of the Public Finance Management (County Government) Regulations, 2015.

- 4. The Village units have not been delineated and Gazetted by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent and they have NOT been approved by the Interested Party herein as per Section 15 (4) of the Bungoma County decentralized units Act, 2015.
- 5. Public participation has not been done on delineation of the village units for the applicants to know which village to apply for as per the advertisement on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2020 by the 3<sup>rd</sup> Respondent that requires the applicant to have stayed in that village for at least 5 years.
- 6. The Advert is discrimination youth aged between 18 years to 24 years, who have been denied a chance to apply for the job because the advert requires applicants to be at least 25 years.
- 7. There is NO established Scheme of service in Bungoma County for village Administrators to give the required qualifications as per Section 36 (1b) of the Public Service Commission Act, 2017.

- 11. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Respondent is fond of advertising for the Village administration since 2018, with changing requirements for lack of Scheme of Service for Village Administrators and not employing without any communication to the applicants thus just wasting applicants' time and resources.
- 12. This application is made in good faith and for the interests of justice.
- 13. No prejudice shall be suffered by the Respondents if this application is granted.



The Salaries and Remuneration Commission deliberated on the remuneration package and held a consultative meeting with the stakeholders of the County Governments on the 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2013 on the subject matter. Consequently, the Commission approved and advise that the public officers serving in the County Government be paid as shown in Table 1 below.

#### Notes

- i) New officers shall join the salary scale at the minimum point on the date of appointment to the County Government, and progress annually to the maximum level.
- ii) Any salary structure existing before the salary structure provided herein ceases to apply forthwith.
- iii) For efficiency and prudence in management of the wage bill, county governments are advised to start off their structures with skeleton staff then build on gradually over time based on the volume and value of the work.
- iv) For effective utilization of staff, county governments are advised to avoid duplication of functions which makes cost of employment expensive.
- v) Multiskilling should be encouraged so that one officer covers a wider scope of work.
- vi) The effective date of this remuneration structure is 1st May 2013.

The purpose of this letter therefore is to communicate the decision and advice of the Salaries and Remuneration Commission for implementation.
