MIN/2/6/03 Assistant Chief said as a matter of urgency, the issue concerning the said Plot 246 of or in Vihiga Company had been wrongfully allocated to a Mr. Bandi, yet it had been allocated as a P.1 plot (Public utility). This had been earlier discussed by Leaders of the Likuyani Location in three Meetings, but despite the outcry from members, Bandi insisted to be the Owner with genuine documents and hence proceeded to Court over the same. An Urgent Meeting (Leaders) of 3/6/03 at the Subchiefs office Serereya suggested that they get the really answer from members of Vihiga itself - and a Meeting was organised today 5/6/03 to ascertain the Truth and hence sign for their Verdict, whether it is Bandi's or for Developments for Public use. MINUTE 2/6/03 SPEECHES:

1. Mzee Luvunga: Said that Bandi who is not a member claimed that 4 people sold the land to him, namely - Alphonse Abwonda, Luka Ludeyo, Sabatia and Michael Angalika.
2. Mr. Alphonse Abwonda who was present, refuted the claims harshly and said we being as a family, we should know how to talk - He said he had been the Secretary to the Caretaker Committee up to 1990 when he ceased the position - He explained that Plot 246 was meant for a Dispensary, Chiefs office land was meant for a Dip, 207 for market, Ivugwi Primary, con-

Monica School and the said Plot 246 - all remained public plots upto date. Title Deeds for other plots were issued title Deeds by the then D.C Leko (Western Prov) P.A.G church gave him money for survey so as to obtain Plot 246, but the Registrar refused for it was a public land. The D.C and Registrar Mr. Omary refused to allow even the P.E.T church who went to NRB to claim it.

He went on, and openly said he doesn't know anything about the selling of Plot 246 - and he gave the sponsors the papers for search in Kakamega.

He said he received Ksh. 6000/- from Bandi and signed for it but it was not meant for land - just for their transport to Nairobi. He's ready to pay him back if asked.

He maintained that people stole other peoples property but used his name. He asked when was it sold, he knows nothing. He fully supports the sponsors (Baptist church) to go ahead and develop the plot. If called, he's ready to tell the truth.

After a lengthy discussion from the attending members, Surprisingly all the 68 sitting members at the Baraza strongly refused to let Bandi step on the said plot and hence they said they'll defend it, but allow the sponsors go ahead and make the very developments. They said, the D.C should help them revoke the case in court and refuted that how could the plot in question be sold without the chief's office knowledge? They denounced such as pure corruption which they'll never condone again. They wrote names and signed.
